

Washington, D.C. – Congressman Tom Rooney (R-Fla.) today announced this year’s Congressional All Services’ Day, where high school students from south central Florida and their parents can find information about service academy and ROTC educational opportunities and scholarships. The event, which will feature presentations by the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard and Merchant Marine Academies, will be held at Homestead Air Reserve Base on April 17, 2010.

“All Services Day is a great chance to learn about the first-class education and scholarship opportunities available through the service academies and ROTC,” Rooney said. “If you are interested in attending one of the service academies or joining ROTC, I strongly encourage you and your parents to attend this event.”

Congressman Rooney is cosponsoring the event with Congressman Ron Klein (D-Fla.). In addition to the presentations, which will begin at 9 am, students will be able to see military combat vehicles up close, including F-16, A-10, Coast Guard helicopter, and Humvee static displays.
